Egypt University of Informatics (EUI) recently concluded its Artificial Intelligence and Knowledge Industry Conference as part of the 55th Cairo International Book Fair. The event, featuring local and international experts and academics, delved into five key



topics: AI and its applications in the knowledge industry, natural language technology, AI's impact on publishing jobs, ethics in AI, and the future of AI in the knowledge industry. The conference aimed to shape the future of publishing and literature amidst the evolving landscape of AI, fostering cooperation with the Cairo International Book Fair.



Data Science Conference MENA 2024 Kickoff event
